

## The Alton and Ibstock Place School Street

We would like to gather views on the proposal to introduce a 'School Street' for **The Alton Primary School and Ibstock Place School**.

### What is a School Street?

A School Street is where one or more roads (or a part of a road) near a school entrance temporarily close to motor traffic at the beginning and end of the school day.

A School Street is designed to reduce the number of vehicles around the school, providing a safer environment for children travelling to and from school. The aim is to:

- Reduce congestion and vehicles travelling through the School Street
- Reduce pollution around the school entrance with fewer engines idling
- Encourage more walking, cycling and active journeys
- Result in less inconsiderate parking and dangerous manoeuvres
- Create a calmer, safer and cleaner environment

School Streets also provide additional space to support social distancing.

## What are the proposals for The Alton School and Ibstock Place School?

We are proposing to make **Danebury Avenue** between **Priory Lane** and **the barrier** a pedestrian and cycle only zone between the hours of **8.00am - 9.00am** and **2.45pm - 4.00pm Monday - Friday** (term time only).

- Signs will inform drivers of the restrictions at the entrance to the School Street
- Temporary barriers may be used to reinforce the restrictions
- Certain essential vehicles are entitled to an exemption from the restrictions
- Any vehicles already within the School Street zone would be permitted to remain or exit
- There will be no changes to parking bays

The school has worked with the council to develop these proposals, which remain subject to feedback and consultation.
