Launching two new bus services to serve Roehampton, including Putney Vale.



Wandsworth Council has funded two new Roehampton bus services, as part of work to improve transport links between Roehampton and the rest of the borough.

This forms a key part of the Alton Renewal Plan, which sets out how the council will invest in the estate, working together with local partners and residents to help this part of Wandsworth to thrive.

■ The University of Roehampton bus

The council has partnered with the University and is part funding the University's shuttle bus. All members of the public can now use it free of charge, hopping on anywhere on its route between Roehampton Vale ASDA and Putney Bridge Station.

■ Roehampton Transport Club

The council has launched a new community minibus designed to connect people in Roehampton who have difficulty using public transport with popular local destinations for **FREE**.

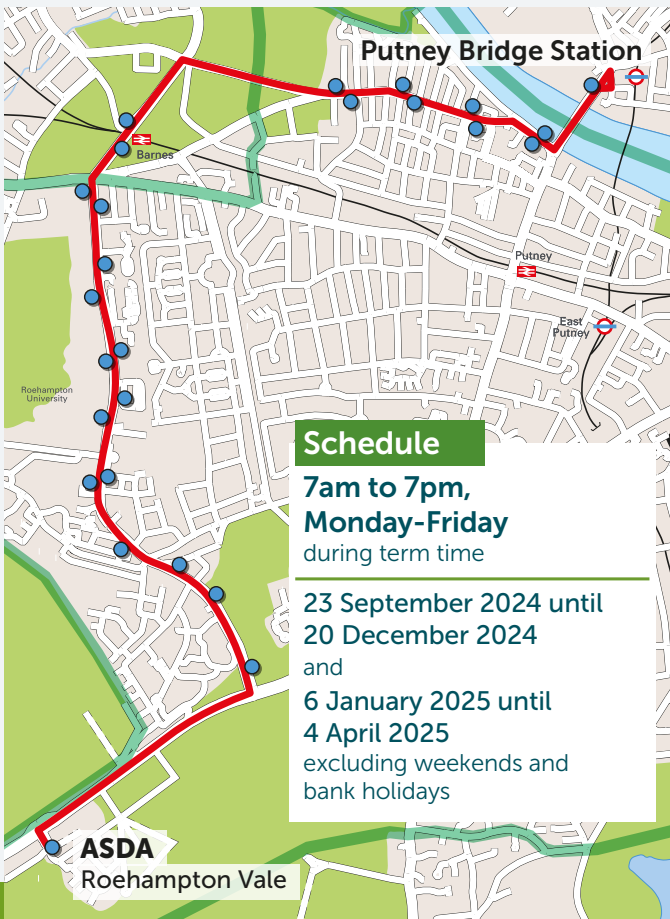


University of Roehampton Bus

Starting **Monday 23 September**, all members of the public can use the University of Roehampton bus for **FREE**.

All you need to do is walk on at any designated TfL bus stop - see map below

This bus runs every 20 minutes between **Roehampton Vale ASDA** and **Putney Bridge Station**



Roehampton Transport Club (RTC)

A new Community Minibus service known as Roehampton Transport Club (RTC) is launching on Tuesday 24 September.

Operated by Wandsworth Community Transport, RTC offers free door-to-door accessible transport to designated local amenities for people in Roehampton who have difficulty using public transport.

How it works

Call Wandsworth Community Transport to request your door-to-door service with RTC, picking you up from anywhere in Roehampton and transporting you to the day's local attraction.

The service is free to use, but places must be booked in advance and space is limited.

How to sign up and book

To book a place on one of RTC's outings, you must first become a member of RTC for free by filling out a membership form either over the phone with Wandsworth Community Transport on **020 8675 3812** or online at: wctbus.org.uk/individuals/membership

Once you have become a member, you can call **Wandsworth Community Transport on 020 8675 3812** to book your place on any of RTC's services.
